

Craft Notes: November 7, 2025

Santa's Workshop 4-Page Scrapbook Workshop

Supplies:

- Santa's Workshop Black Friday Bundle
- Bright White Cardstock (3)
- Black Cardstock (1)
- Black Micro-Tip Pen
- White Twine (Hobby Lobby)
- Red and Green Gems (Michael's Recollection Brand)



Step 1: Use (2) 12" x 12" pieces of Bright White cardstock for the bases.

Step 2: Cut (2) 6" x 9" Green and Red Plaid pieces. Adhere them to the bases along the top and inside edges.

Step 3: Cut (2) 4½" x 6½" Dark Green Houndstooth pieces. Adhere 3" from the bottom and 1¼" from the outside edges of the pages.

Step 4: Cut (2) 4¼" x 3¼" and (2) 4¼" x 4¼" Cranberry Dot pieces. On the left page, place the smaller mat 5/8" from the bottom and 7/8" from the right edge of the plaid. Leaving ¼" in between, place the larger photo mat above. **TIP: Use the squares on the plaid to place your photo mats.** On the right page, place the larger mat 5/8" from the bottom and 7/8" from the right edge of the plaid. Leave ¼" in between, place the smaller mat above.

Step 5: Draw doodle lines on the top and outside edges of the pages in the white space.

Step 6: Punch the following trains in 12" lengths:

- (2) Black cardstock
- (2) Red Diagonal
- (2) Green Houndstooth.

With the black trains, leave ½" below the bottom of the tracks and adhere to the bottom of the bases. Cut (2) 12" x ½" pieces of Bright White, and tear along one long edge on each one. You will adhere this to the bottom of the page over the black to mimic snow.

Cut the trees from the Green Houndstooth paper. Glue them to the black trains. Cut the Red Diagonal engines and cars from the punched trains. Look closely at the photo to see how I have cut them. Note that you leave one engine and one car together. Glue to the top of the black trains.

Step 7: If you use the same embellishments as I did, put white cardstock behind "Wishlist," "Oh, What Fun," and "North Pole." This little step allows them to be read clearly. Finish with remaining embellishments, twine bows, and gems.

Step 8: My journaling strips are 9" x 3/8", and I have cut six. You can also print them on a 8.5" x 11" piece of white cardstock and cut them apart into strips.



Step 1: Use (2) 12" x 12" pieces of Bright White cardstock for the bases.

Step 2: Cut (2) 12" x 4" Green Toy Pieces. Adhere them along the bottom of the pages. Follow by adding a 1/8" strip of Cranberry Dots along the top of each of these pieces.

Step 3: Punch the following trains in 12" lengths:

- (2) Black cardstock
- (2) Green Houndstooth.

With the black trains, leave $\frac{1}{4}$ " below the bottom of the tracks and adhere along the bottom print. Next, cut the trees from the Green Houndstooth paper. Glue them to the black trains.

Step 4: Cut (2) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Wood Grain pieces. Adhere $3\frac{1}{2}$ " from the bottom and $\frac{3}{4}$ " from the inside edges of the pages. Cut (2) $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $6\frac{1}{4}$ " Red Grid pieces. Place them in the center of the Wood Grain to complete the photo mat. **TIP: If you would like a white photo mat**

under your photo to make them pop a little more, simple cut white mats 1/8" larger than the photo OR print your photos with a white border.

Step 5: Cut (2) 6" x 4" Red Grid pieces. Leaving 1/8" in between, place the horizontal piece next to the outside edges of the large photo mats and even with the top.

Step 6: Draw doodle lines on the top and outside edges of the pages in the white space.

Step 7: If you use the same embellishments as I did, put Bright White cardstock behind "Naughty" and "Santa's Workshop." Finish with remaining embellishments, twine bows, and gems.

Step 8: My journaling strips are 9" x 3/8", and I have cut six. You can also print them on a 8.5" x 11" piece of white cardstock and cut them apart into strips.
