MY PAPERCRAFTING LIFE

Hydrangea Haven and Diamond Lattice Stencil One-Page Layout



Supplies:

- Hydrangea Haven Paper Pack
- Hydrangea Haven Stickers
- Hydrangea Haven Embellishments
- Bright White Cardstock (1)
- Diamond Lattice Stencil
- Summer Sky Ink and Matching Blending Brush

- Lulu Lavender Ink
- Place and Peel Tape
- Paintbrush
- Water Mister
- Non-Sticker Craft Mat

Step 1: Use Bright White cardstock for the base of the layout. Add Place and Peel Tape around the outer edges of your stencil. Stencil the diamond lattice pattern with Summer Sky ink three places on the base: the lower right corner, the middle of the left edge, and a larger section that is 2 ½" from the right edge and the bottom. TIP: When you are using a stencil like this, start in the center and then use a lighter hand as you go a little further out. This will give you the appearance of fading. Finish inking the base by splattering over the stenciled sections with Lulu Lavender ink.

Step 2: Cut (1) piece of Light Blue designer paper at 3" x 10". Dovetail the bottom end. TIP: When dovetailing, use the tip of your scissors to make a small cut up the center of the paper. Then cut from the corner to the center on each side. Stencil the diamond lattice pattern with Summer Sky ink at the top and bottom left edges. Follow by splattering over those stenciled parts with Lulu Lavender ink. Adhere this piece 1 ½" from the left edge and against the top of the page.

Step 3: Next, cut (1) 6" x 6" piece of hydrangea paper with the white background. Place 2" from the left edge and 1 ½" from the top. Follow by cutting (1) 10" x 3" piece of light blue hydrangea paper. Adhere 1" from the left edge and 2 ½" from the top. Finish the paper cluster by cutting (1) 5" x 5" green plaid. Add to page 3" from the right edge and 2" from the top.

Step 4: Cut (1) 5-1/8" x 3-1/8" and (1) 4-1/8" x 3-1/8" dark blue designer paper. These are your mats for (1) 5 x 3 and (1) 4 x 3 photo. The larger mat is 2 ¼" from the top and 2" from the right edge. The smaller mat is 2½" from the left edge and 3 ¾" from the bottom.

Step 5: Cut a 5" x 1 ½" piece of green plaid. Place 1" from the bottom and against the right edge. Next cut a piece 6" x ½" light blue paper. Stencil with the Summer Sky ink and the diamond lattice stencil. Adhere 1 ¼" from the bottom and against the right edge.

Step 6: Finish your page with journaling, stickers, and embellishments. Use thin foam adhesive as desired.
