MY PAPERCRAFTING LIFE

Free Spirit and Stars Stencil One-Page Layout



Supplies:

- Free Spirit Paper Pack
- Free Spirit Embellishments
- Free Spirit Mat Cards
- Bright White Cardstock (1 sheet)
- Stars Stencil

- Lilac Posies Ink and Matching Brush
- Tangelo Ink and Matching Brush
- Place and Peel Tape
- Paintbrush
- Water Mister
- 12" Trimmer
- Micro-Tip Scissors
- Repositionable Tape Runner
- Thin Foam Squares or Roll
- Craft Mat

Step 1: The Purple Sun paper is your base. Gut a 10" square from the center. Follow by cutting an 11 ¼" x 11 ¼" piece of Bright White cardstock. Use Tangelo ink to splatter the upper left and lower right corners. Adhere cardstock to base.

Step 2: Cut (1) 6" x 6" piece of rainbow stripe paper diagonally and adhere 1 ¾" from the bottom of the left and right sides. Cut a 5" x 5" piece of feather paper diagonally (use the reverse side). Use Place and Peel to tape off two rows of stars. On the long ends of the two diagonal cuts, stencil the two rows of stars. Adhere to the center and against the edges of the diagonal rainbow paper. Next, tape off one star. Stencil the star with Lilac Posies in a grouping of three over the upper left and lower right splattered areas.

Step 3: Use the reverse side of the gutted Purple Sun paper to cut three photo mats. You will need (3) 4 ½" x 3 ½" pieces. The layered mat is Bright White cardstock and is 4 1/8" x 3 1/8". Start by placing the center mat 3 ¾" from the left edge and 4 ¼" from the bottom. Center the other mats above and below.

Step 4: The bucket list mat card is cut to 3 ¼" x 4 ½". Angle, tuck under photo mats, and adhere it 2" from the bottom. Next, find the mat card that says "wild landscapes...". Cut around the frame on the card and angle, tuck under the photos, and place it 2" from the top.

Step 5: Finish with journaling and embellishments. Use thin foam adhesive as desired.
