Holiday Elements Stencil One-Page Layout



Supplies:

- Magic of Christmas Paper Pack
- Magic of Christmas Stickers
- Bright White Cardstock (2)
- Holiday Elements Stencil
- Dark Green Ink (Northern Pine) and Matching Blending Brush
- Cranberry Ink (Love Letter) and Matching Blending Brush
- Beige Ink (Toffee Crunch) and Matching Blending Brush
- Jumbo Circle CCS

- Cyclic Chain BMC
- Border Maker System
- Place and Peel Tape
- Non-Sticker Craft Mat
- 12" Trimmer
- Micro-Tip Scissors
- Repositionable Tape Runner
- Thin Foam Squares

Step 1: Use Holly & Bough print for base. Set aside.

Step 2: Cut Bright White cardstock down to an 11 ½" square. Use the Jumbo Circle CCS, to lightly trace a circle (inside of template) in the center of the page. This will be your guideline for stenciling the vines and holly leaves in Northern Pine ink. Tape off the holly leaves and blend around the circle so that the leaves cross both sides of the circle. Wipe off your stencil with a paper towel and tape off one of the leaf vines around the large flower. Stencil this vine in and around the holly leaves. Tape off the holly berries and stencil three sets in the top right and lower left of the page.

Step 3: Tape off the ornament hangers. You will need Toffee Crunch ink to stencil 3 of these at the top of the wreath. Make sure you have enough room between them for the ornaments. Tape off the ornament balls and stencil them below the hangers using Love Letter ink. Use a sticker bow to decorate the center ornament. Adhere Bright White square to base.

Step 4: Cut (1) 10 ¼" x 3 ½" piece of Red Bows paper. Place centered left to right and below the ornaments. Follow by cutting (3) 3 ¼" x 3 ¼" pieces of dark green paper and (3) 3-1/8" x 3-1/8" pieces of Bright White. Layer 3" x 3" photos on to the white and then layer those on the green pieces. Center the three photos on the Red Bows paper. On the extra Bright White paper, stencil (2) large flowers with Love Letter ink. Fussy cut them and then layer one on top of the other with 3-D foam. Alternate the petals between the two so that they look full. Adhere the flower to the lower right corner of the photo mat. Use the Cyclic Chain BMC to make one circle from the Red Bows paper. This is the center of your flower.

Step 5: Choose any sentiment to finish the floral cluster on the bottom right of the mat.
